



What is Policy?



Policy: a course or principle of action adopted or proposed by an organization or individual.

Policy is any document that lays out ways of thinking, actions proposed, rules and guidance.

Policies we need to be aware of come from government on issues in HE, the regulators, university policies, trade unions, SU policy (created by students).



Who is Making HE Policy?

Office for Students

Regulator for HE - sets expectations and can 'punish' HEPs

OIA

Regulator for student complaints - can overturn complaint outcomes

DfE

Civil Service department - will write policy for ministers

EPS

University department - creates and oversee uni policies

Student Council

Students creating policy for the SU - what we need to stick by

Politicians

Prime Minister, Ministers, Secretary of States
